Detmold-based electronics specialist Weidmüller celebrates 25 and 40 years of company service with 95 international long-serving employees from three countries.

The family-owned company Weidmüller held its international long-service awards party for 95 long-serving employees from three countries with 25 or 40 years of service on 27 November 2015. The guests from Sweden, Spain and Germany travelled to attend the event accompanied by their partners. The Detmold-based, family-run company has been hosting such an event every November since 2010, to honour the long service of their staff who work around the world for the Group.
